

DIVERSITY EQUITY INCLUSION

A MANAGEMENT COUNCIL UPDATE

The Management Council previously announced collaborating with the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Task Force in the presentation of a Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Speaker series. With the hiring of our first Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Officer, Phin Xaypangna, there has been some foundational reorganization around the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) work plan and as an extension of the Diversity Panels that were held last summer, many have requested space for more in depth dialogue about race and diversity. To answer that call, County leadership led the way engaging in 'Talking Together in Challenging Times', discussions on race facilitated by Phin Xaypangna and other members of the DEI Leadership Accountability Team. These sessions, available to all departments and being done as you read, are safe spaces to talk, learn and hopefully understand more about individuals that we work with that may not look like us or have our personal backgrounds, as well as processing feelings around some of the events that occurred last year both nationally and locally, as it relates to race. The planned workshops and book discussions will likely be on hold for now while these discussions occur, but look for more to come in the coming months-we are excited about all the movement in this critical space.

To the extent that time allows, questions will also be taken live during the event. An appointment with log in information will be sent in advance of the meeting and we hope to 'see' you there!


